

Early lead not enough for the [Pendleton Bulldogs \(V\)](#), drop 6-5 decision to Clinton (SC)

The Pendleton Bulldogs jumped out to an early lead, but were unable to hold on and lost 6-5 to Clinton on Monday.

While the Pendleton Bulldogs led until the eleventh inning, Clinton worked its way back and took the lead on an error.

[Abram Cannady](#) racked up three RBIs on two hits for the Pendleton Bulldogs . He homered in the first inning and doubled in the third inning.
