

Seneca outdone by [Abram Cannady](#) and the [Pendleton Bulldogs \(V\)](#), 9-6

[Abram Cannady](#) went 2-3 and hit a home run as the Pendleton Bulldogs took home a 9-6 victory over Seneca in seven innings at Pendleton on Monday.

He homered in the third inning and singled in the fifth inning.

Even though [Aaron Wimpey](#) allowed six runs over seven innings he still recorded the victory. He struck out one, walked six and surrendered nine hits.

[Petey Ridley](#) was charged with the loss. He lasted just two innings, walked none, struck out two, and allowed five runs.

The game was never in doubt after the second, as the Pendleton Bulldogs scored three runs on a two-run home run by [Cole Simpson](#) and a groundout by [Collin Bunch](#).

One run in the top of the fourth helped Seneca close its deficit to 5-1. An RBI single by [Cayde Hamilton](#) gave Seneca life. The Seneca threat came to an end when Wimpey finally got [Landon Mclane](#) to fly out.

After a quick strike from Seneca, the Pendleton Bulldogs responded with two runs in the fourth. The Pendleton Bulldogs scored on an RBI single by [Gibson Black](#) and a sacrifice fly by [Drake McConnell](#).

Three runs in the top of the fifth helped Seneca close its deficit to 7-4. An RBI double by [Alex Medlin](#), an error, and an RBI single by [Trey Hawk](#) fueled Seneca's comeback. Finally, Wimpey got Hamilton to ground out to end the threat.

The Pendleton Bulldogs tacked on another two runs in the fifth. Cannady's single got things going, scoring [Hank Martin](#). That was followed up by McConnell's single, bringing home Black.

After pushing across one run in the top of the sixth, Seneca faced just a 9-5 deficit. An RBI single by [Tristen Hudson](#) set off Seneca rally. The Pendleton Bulldogs stopped the rally after Wimpey got [Braxton Gambrell](#) to fly out.

Seneca scored one run in the top of the seventh to cut its deficit to three. A walk by Medlin gave Seneca life. The Pendleton Bulldogs 's Wimpey induced a [Elijah Turner](#) to close things out.
