

# Aaron Wimpey gives the Pendleton Bulldogs (V) late push to beat Woodruff (SC), 3-2

Aaron Wimpey drove in the winning run to give the Pendleton Bulldogs the lead in the sixth inning, as the Pendleton Bulldogs hung on to beat Woodruff 3-2 on Friday.

Hank Martin walked to get on base in the sixth. He then went from first to third on a single by Gibson Black.
