

Offenses dominate as the [Pendleton Bulldogs \(V\)](#) outscore [Woodruff \(SC\)](#) 11-8

Scoreboard operators were busy at Pendleton High on Thursday as the Pendleton Bulldogs and Woodruff combined for 19 runs. Pendleton Bulldogs (V) eventually won the offensive battle 11-8 in seven innings.

The teams totaled 23 hits, including four extra base hits in the game.

[Cole Simpson](#) racked up three RBIs on three hits for the Pendleton Bulldogs . He doubled in the first inning and singled in the second and third innings.

[Drake McConnell](#) recorded the win for the Pendleton Bulldogs . He allowed two runs over five innings. He struck out four, walked two and surrendered four hits.

Stewart was the game's losing pitcher. He allowed seven runs in 1 1/3 innings, walked one and struck out four.

The Pendleton Bulldogs never surrendered the lead after the first inning, scoring three runs on an RBI double by Simpson and two singles.

One run in the top of the second helped Woodruff close its deficit to 3-1. An RBI single by Patterson sparked Woodruff 's rally. Warren to end the Woodruff (SC) threat.

The Pendleton Bulldogs answered Woodruff 's top inning with four runs of their own in the second. The Pendleton Bulldogs scored on an RBI single by Simpson, a two-run single by [Gibson Black](#), and a passed ball.

The Pendleton Bulldogs added three more runs in the bottom of the third. Simpson kicked things off with a single, plating [Collin Bunch](#).

Six runs in the top of the seventh helped Woodruff close its deficit to 11-8. A single by Warren, an RBI single by Brockman, an RBI single by Rotter, and a three-run home run by Skinner triggered Woodruff 's comeback. The game went final when Mossbrook struck out.
